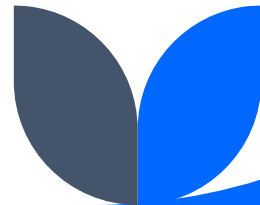

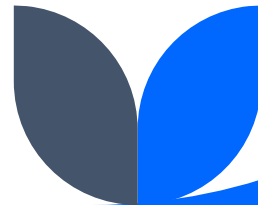

3) Sacrifice?

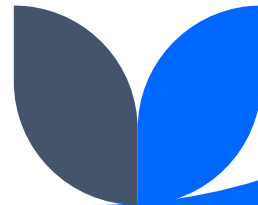
- I have fallen in love with teaching

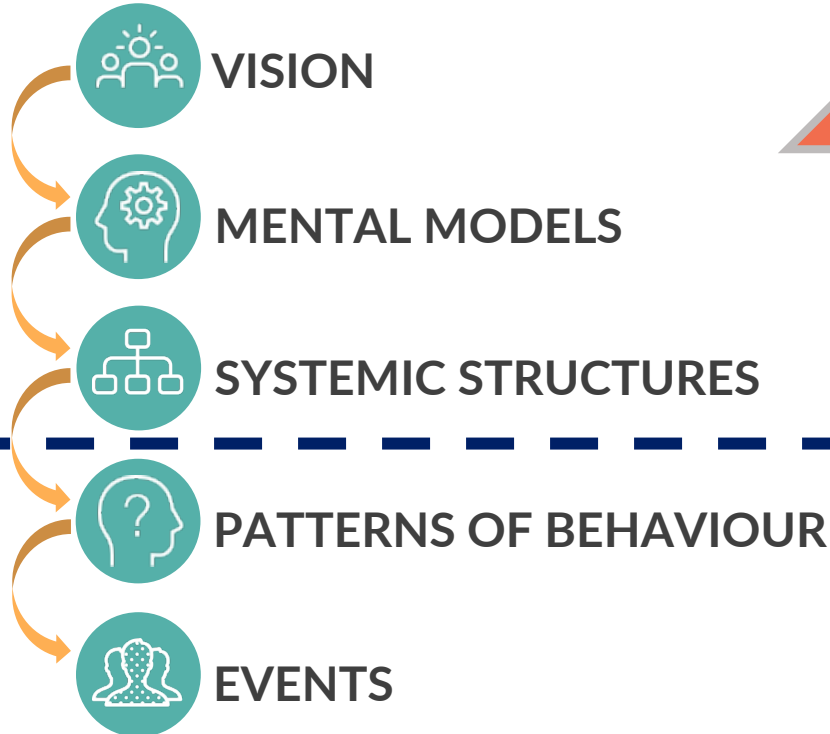

LEADERS

- Work at top three levels of perspective

- Must walk the talk, transform not transact

6 October 2022

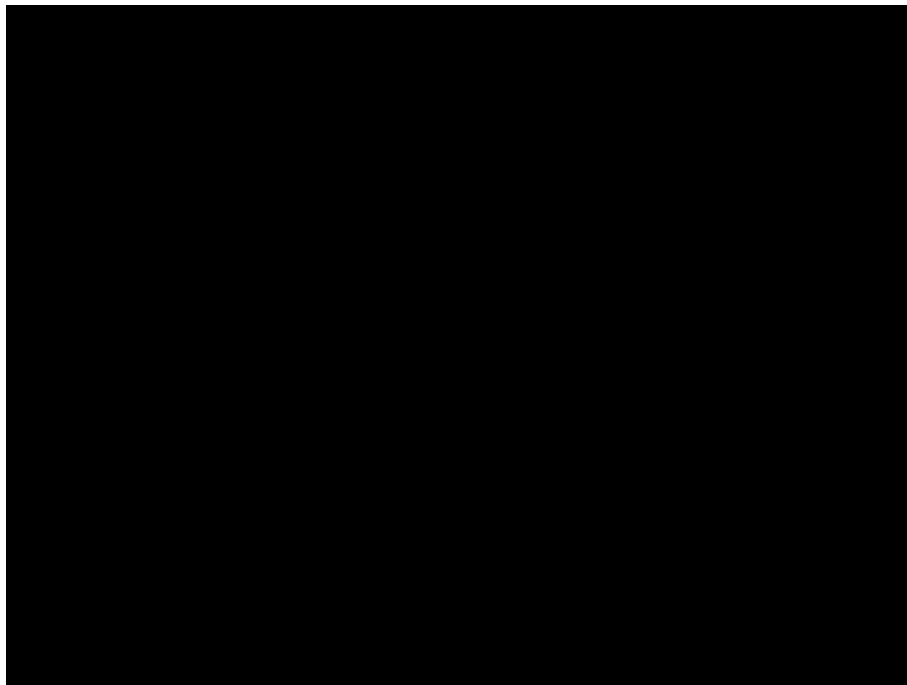
- Planning Day # 2: 2023 prefect elect and Year 9 junior leaders, teaching and non teaching staff

Term 2, Week 1:

All Student Leadership Groups, including the Science Ambassadors pre-read 2022 reports and met in the hall to Reimagine student leadership @ Wavell:

- Nektarios, Kingston, Mei Mei and Toni-Lee (Yr 10) outlined process + recommendations from 2022 planning days.
- School Captains outlined proposed next steps: to co-develop a plan to ensure a more interconnected student leadership group across years 7 to 12
- Each leadership group nominated a representative to attend the next meeting on co-developing the purpose of why Student Leadership exists at Wavell SHS.

Term 1, Weeks 9 and 10:

We gathered information about meeting frequency, purpose and initiatives from each of the Student Leadership Groups: Arts, Languages, Sports/House, Student Representative Council, Junior Leaders, Prefects.

Term 2, Week 2:

- Representatives from each Student Leadership Group co-constructed a purpose statement (Our why)

Inspire – creates confidence to do

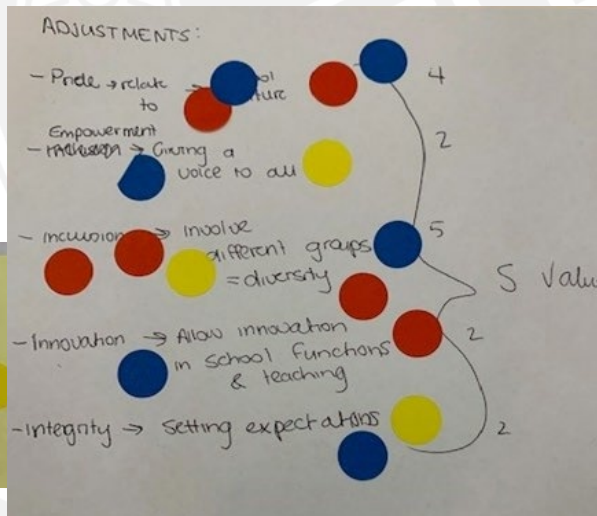
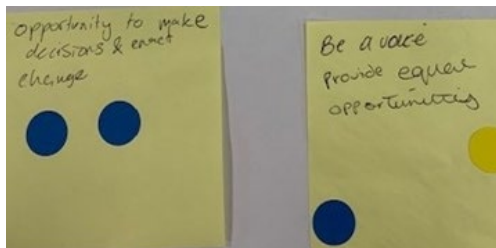

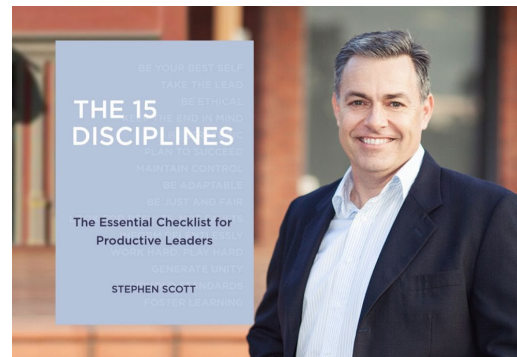
